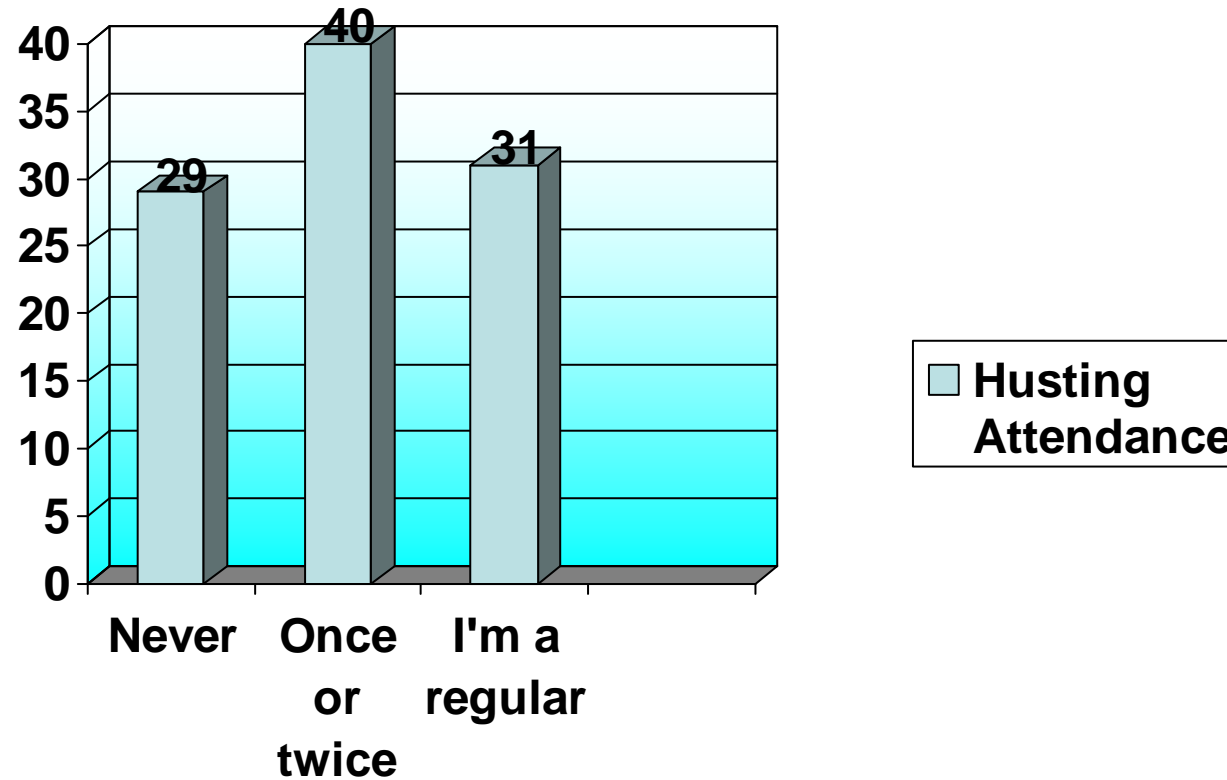

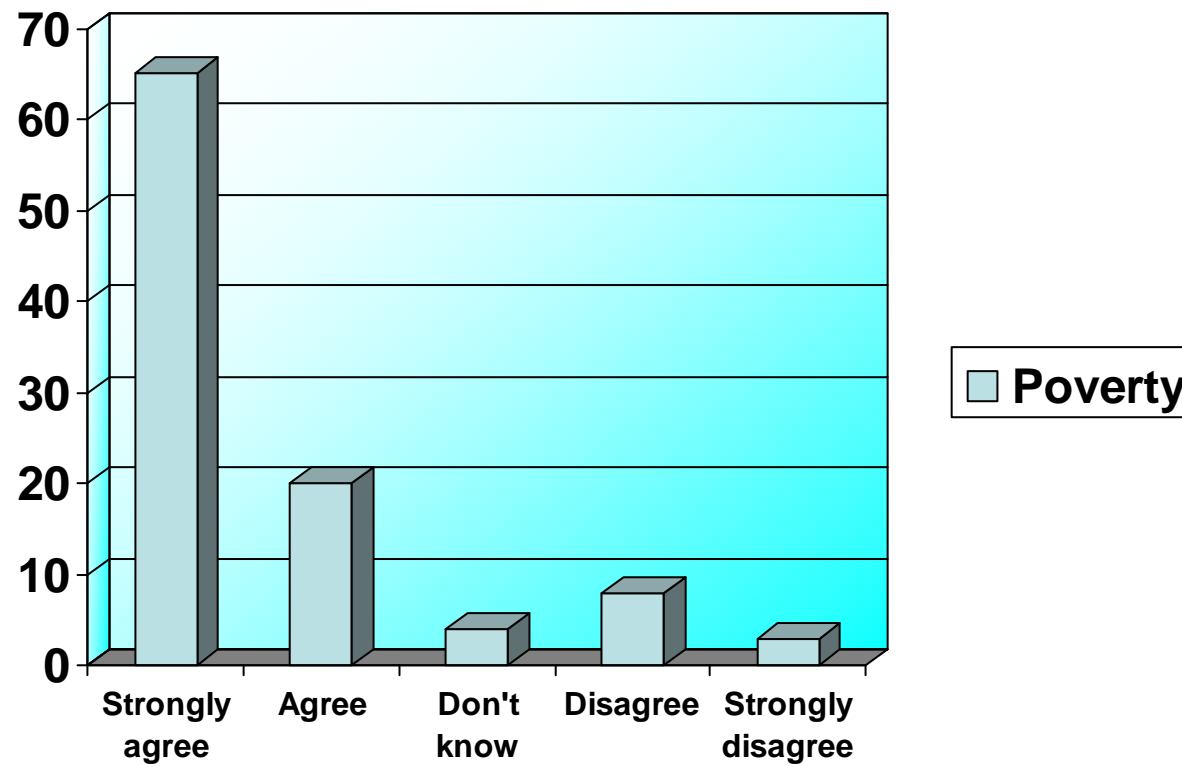
Notes and Guidance

- The results are displayed as % of those voting

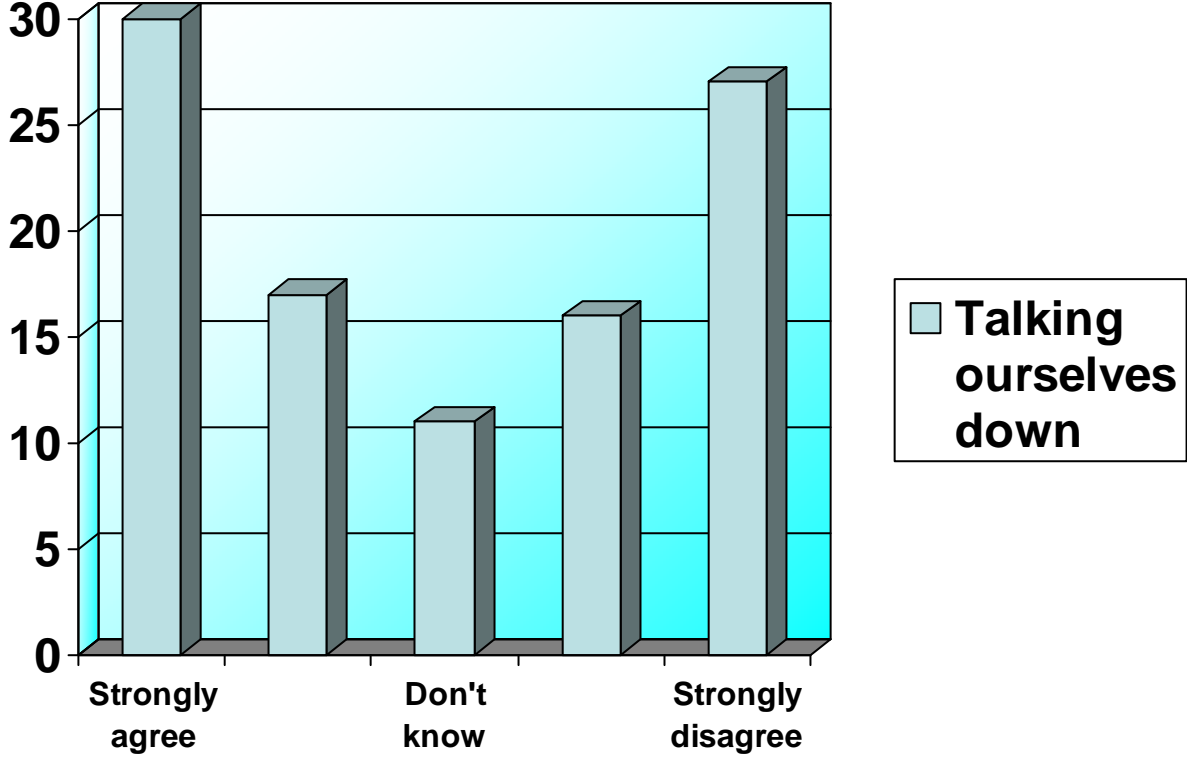

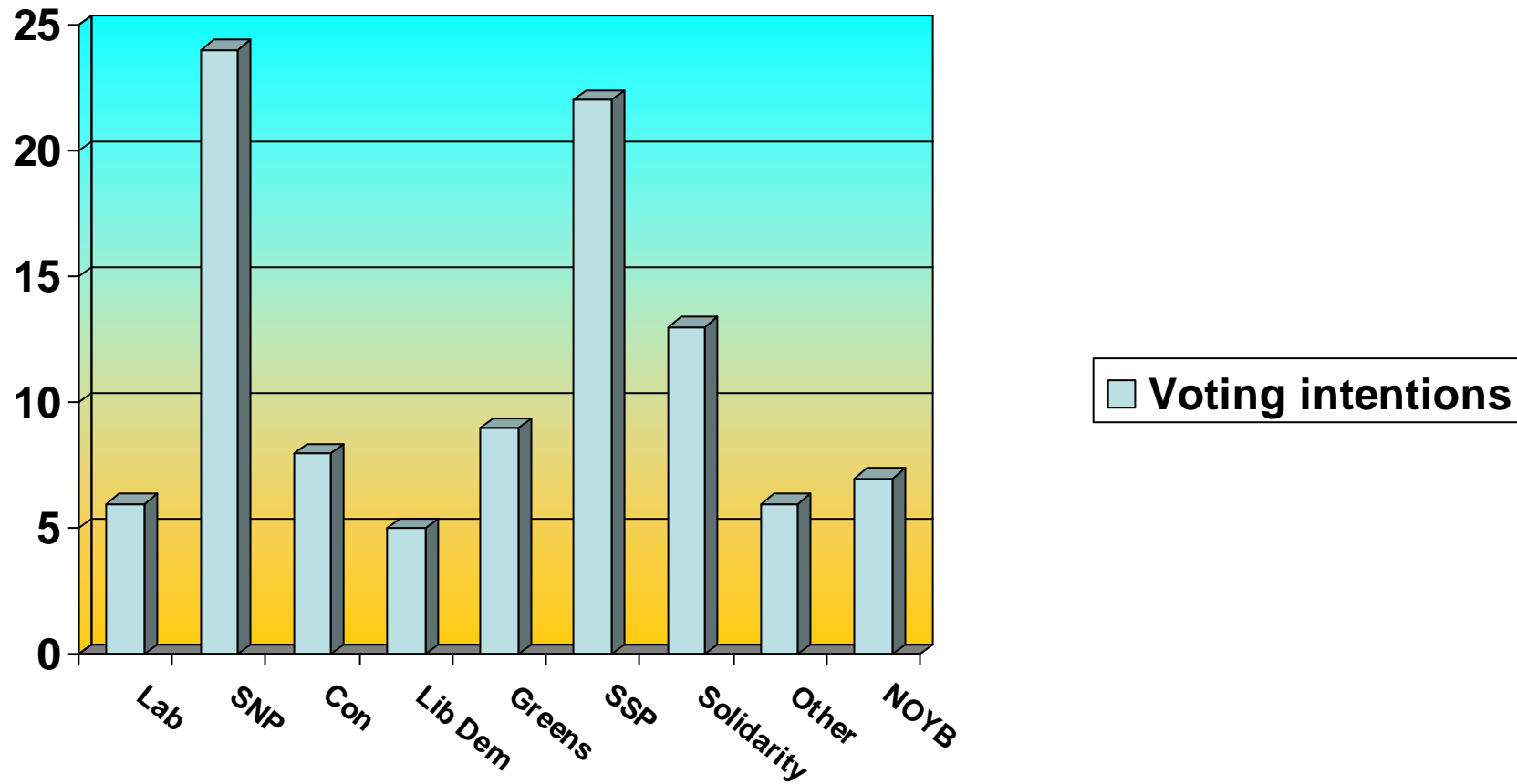
